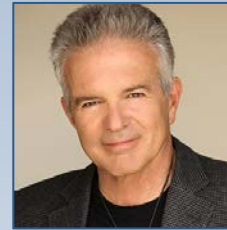

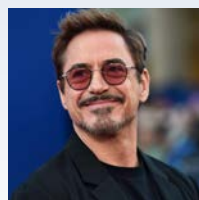

Proceeds from the *Experience, Strength and Hope Awards* go to produce the national REEL Recovery Film Festival & Symposium®.

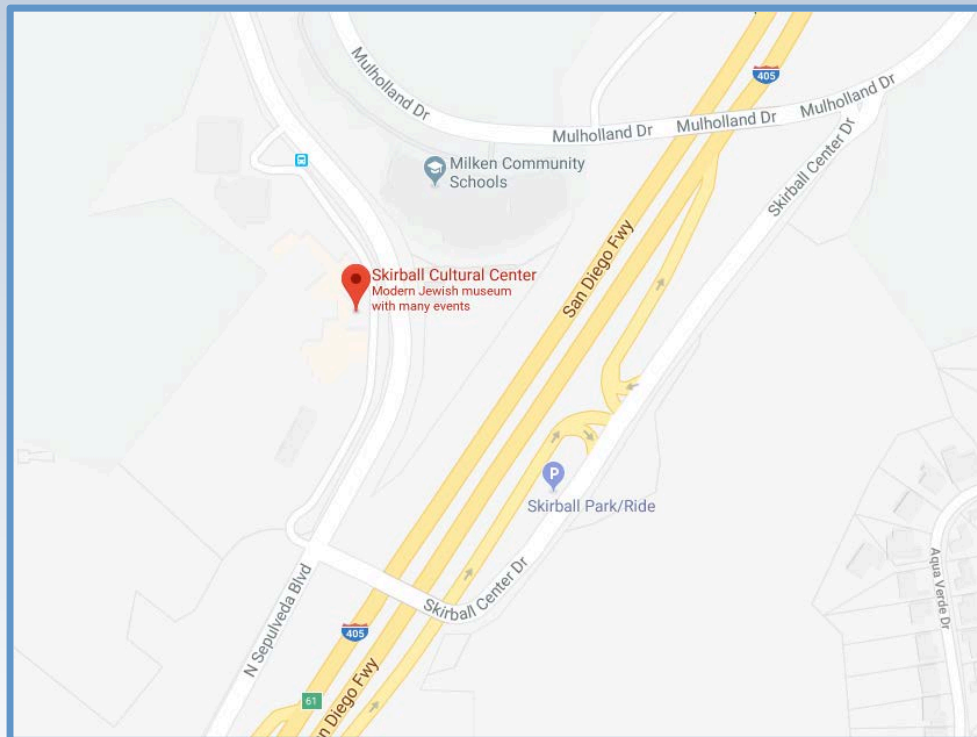


THE SKIRBALL CULTURAL CENTER

Mr. Buschel is the founder of Writers In Treatment whose primary purpose is to promote 'treatment' as the best first step solution for addiction, alcoholism and other self-destructive behaviors.
